



A statutory board established under the Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a board meeting on **Wednesday, 16 February 2022** to consider, among other things, applications under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007*, *Casino Control Act 1992*, *Liquor Act 2007*, *Gaming Machines Act 2001* and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*. The next ILGA board meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday 16 March 2022**.

ILGA considered the following matters and the status of each matter is listed below.
