



A statutory board established under the Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (ILGA) held a meeting of its Liquor & Gaming Committee on **Wednesday, 15 June 2022** to consider, among other things, applications under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007*, *Liquor Act 2007*, *Gaming Machines Act 2001* and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*. The next ILGA Liquor & Gaming Committee meeting is scheduled for **Friday, 15 July 2022**.
